

Dear Voter,

Our office recently received a Washington State voter registration form which you filled out and submitted. The form asks newly registered voters to provide either their Washington State driver's license number or, if they do not have a driver's license, the last four digits of their Social Security number. If a voter provides their driver's license number, the name they print on the registration form must **exactly match** the name printed on their driver's license. If a new voter only provides the last four digits of their Social Security number, the name they print on the voter form must exactly match the name on their Social Security card. Providing this information allows the verification of the voter's information against the State file of drivers or the Federal file of Social Security numbers. This verification is a requirement of both Federal and State law and must be done before a new voter can be accepted as a valid voter. The purpose of the verification is to eliminate the submission of fraudulent registrations.

Unfortunately the form you submitted was lacking some necessary information or the name you printed on the form does not match the name as printed on your driver's license or Social Security card, if that is the number you wrote on the form. Would you please provide only the information indicated below by an "X" on the left hand side.
