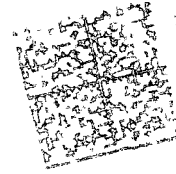

## Voting Instruction Check List

*Make sure your vote counts!*

- The most effective way to mark your ballot is to **completely fill in the oval** with a dark pen like this: 

- If you make an error, draw an "X" through the error and fill in the correct oval.

- Do not initial, sign or make stray or identifying marks on your ballot.
- To cast a **write-in** vote for a candidate not listed on the ballot, print his or her name on the blank line and **completely fill in the oval**.

**INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS:**

Use a dark pen to fill in the oval next to your choice. VOTE LIKE THIS:  Fill in the oval completely. If you vote in error at the polls, return the ballot to a poll worker and get another one.

**IMPORTANT PRIMARY VOTING INSTRUCTIONS**

**1. Select one political party preference below.**

If you do not select a party preference or if you select more than one party, your votes for partisan candidates will not count.

**2. Vote for candidates from the party you selected.**

This ballot is color-coded to assist you in selecting contests which correspond to your party selection. Votes for another party's candidates will not count.

**3. Vote for nonpartisan offices and ballot measures.**

These votes will be counted, even if you do not mark a political party.

**Nonpartisan:** Not associated with any one political party

**Primary:** In the Primary you choose candidates who will run in the General Election

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR A WRITE-IN VOTE:** To cast a write-in vote for a candidate not listed on the ballot, print his or her name on the blank line and completely fill in the oval.

**OATH OF VOTER**

*I do solemnly swear or affirm, under penalty of perjury that*

- I am a legal resident of the state of Washington;
- I am entitled to vote in this election;
- I have not already voted in this election;
- It is illegal to vote if I am not a United States citizen;
- It is illegal to vote if I have been convicted of a felony and have not had my voting rights restored;
- It is illegal to cast a ballot or sign an absentee envelope on behalf of another voter, except as otherwise provided by law, and
- Attempting to vote when not entitled, attempting to vote more than once, or falsely signing this oath is a felony punishable by a maximum imprisonment of five years, a maximum fine of \$10,000, or both.

If you are unable to sign your name, you may mark an "X" and have it witnessed and signed by two (2) people:
