9. On 09/16/05 I was in uniform and in a marked patrol vehicle as 3-Charley-3, with Officer Whitlatch. I was dispatched to a call for a dispute between a cab driver and his passenger. I arrived and contacted the cab driver to find out what happened. V [REDACTED] reported that he had just dropped off an intoxicated man at 12th Ave E/ E Thomas St, and S [REDACTED] didn't have any money to pay for the cab fare. The passenger S [REDACTED] provided a credit card to V [REDACTED] to pay for the fare of \$16.50, but the card was declined. V [REDACTED] said that S/Johnson got irritated and grabbed V [REDACTED] cell phone and threw it down. The cell phone separated into two pieces. V [REDACTED] thought that his cell phone was broken, but he was able to put the pieces back together and the phone functions as normal. As I was talking with V [REDACTED] the S [REDACTED] came back to the cab and stated, "I came back to pay for my cab." I talked with S [REDACTED] who was highly intoxicated and unable to stop swaying and slurring his speech. I told S [REDACTED] that if he didn't pay for the cab fare, I was going to arrest him for theft. S [REDACTED] stated,

"What, you don't have anything better to do than arrest guys for skipping out on their cab fare!" S [redacted] was highly uncooperative and kept asking why I didn't have better things to do than arrest guys for not paying a cab driver. I told S [redacted] that he could pay for the fare right now and he would be released to go home. S [redacted] said, "Okay, use one of my credit cards." I gave the V [redacted] the credit card from S [redacted] wallet that he wanted to use out of the five that he had in his possession. This credit card came back as being declined as well. I then told S [redacted] that he had one more chance, and what credit card would he like to try this time out of the three credit cards that were remaining to be tried? S [redacted] stated, "I don't want to pay, arrest me!" I arrested S [redacted] for the theft and read him his Miranda warnings. S [redacted] said, "I'm a lawyer and I don't understand anything that you said to me." I asked him what he didn't understand and he asked, "Why am I being arrested?" I transported S [redacted] to the E pct. and Officer Pendergrass transported him to the KCJ for booking. Arrest screened by A/SGT. Moore.
