Dear Mr. Huennekens,

Per our telephone conversation this morning I am hereby requesting the following lists of King County voters who submitted ballots in the Nov.2, 2004 general election, in computer parsable format on CD ROM.

1) A list of all King County voters who submitted ballots in the Nov. 2 election. This list should include at least the following data items for each voter, as of the day of the election:

- * voter_id
- * first, last and middle names
- * residence address
- * mailing address
- * precinct
- * date of registration
- * gender
- * date of birth
- * type of ballot submitted, consistent with the notation in the precinct canvass files (e.g. POLLING, ABSENTEE, ADD-ON)
- * indication whether the ballot was accepted or rejected

In addition, please provide separate lists of the following:

2) the complete list of voters whose ballots were among the approximately 720-730 absentee ballots that were determined to have been improperly rejected and later reviewed by the canvassing board. This list should include at least the name and voter id for each voter and an indication whether or not the ballot was among the 566 that were ultimately accepted by the canvassing board.

3) the list of voters whose ballots were among the approximately 20 ballots that were discovered stuck in ballot boxes during the manual recount and ultimately rejected by the canvassing board. This list should include at least the name and voter id for each voter and the precinct and polling place where the ballot was discovered.

It was my understanding that at least the complete voter list (1) will be available this Wednesday, December 29, 2004. Please confirm and let me know when on Wednesday I can pick up the CD from the King County Records and Elections Office. If it takes longer to prepare lists (2) and (3), kindly let me know when they will be available and please deliver them by e-mail to this address.
