Bill,

Thank you so much for helping us out during such a busy time for you! I'm sorry it has taken me so long to get back to you - I was out of town for a few days.

I have a few questions about the file that you gave me:

- 1) I have taken the codes and separated them under either fatal or soft pend, depending on where I think they go. (see below) Can you confirm that this interpretation is correct?
- 2) I'm unclear on what the following codes mean:
 - NOT (this starts on 27488)
 - OFFICE PEND FATAL (STREET EVALUATION)
 - OFFICE PEND SOFT (STREET EVALUATION)
 - Change of Address Soft
 - Name Change Soft
- 3) In your response to our survey, you mentioned that applicants in the fatal pend list are not processed and then a letter or phone call are made when possible. Have all of the people on this file been contacted? Do you keep records of how many of these contacts have been made and who they are made to? Is one contact made or are they called twice? If Project Vote wanted to help follow up on these voters, do you have a suggestion as to which list would be best to start with?
- 4) In your response to our survey, you said that applications submitted without either a driver's license number or the last four digits of the social security number are sent a letter and then allowed to vote a provisional ballot. Does this letter instruct the voter to go to the polls on election day and vote? Is this a simple form letter that I could see?
- 5) It's my understanding that the applicants listed under "underage voter" will NOT be 18 by Nov 2, and that anyone else who is currently 17 but will be 18 by that time was not put on this list - that they have been processed. Is this correct?
