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II. BASIS

Findings of fact and conclusions of law have been entered in this case.

III. DECREE

IT IS DECREED that:

3.1 STATUS OF THE MARRIAGE.

The marriage of the parties is dissolved.

3.2 PROPERTY TO BE AWARDED THE HUSBAND.

The husband is awarded as his separate property the property set forth in Exhibit A. This exhibit is attached or filed and incorporated by reference as part of this Decree.

3.3 PROPERTY TO BE AWARDED TO THE WIFE.

The wife is awarded as her separate property the property set forth in Exhibit A. This exhibit is attached or filed and incorporated by reference as part of this Decree.

3.4 LIABILITIES TO BE PAID BY THE HUSBAND.

The husband shall pay the community or separate liabilities set forth in Exhibit B. This exhibit is attached or filed and incorporated by reference as part of this Decree.

Unless otherwise provided herein, the husband shall pay all liabilities incurred by him since the date of separation.

3.5 LIABILITIES TO BE PAID BY THE WIFE.

The wife shall pay the community or separate liabilities set forth in Exhibit B. This exhibit is attached or filed and incorporated by reference as part of this Decree.

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Unless otherwise provided herein, the wife shall pay all liabilities incurred by her since the date of separation.

3.6 HOLD HARMLESS PROVISION.

Each party shall hold the other party harmless from any collection action relating to separate or community liabilities set forth above, including reasonable attorney's fees and costs incurred in defending against any attempts to collect an obligation of the other party.

3.7 SPOUSAL MAINTENANCE.

The husband shall pay \$500.00 maintenance. Maintenance shall be paid monthly in two equal installments on the 5th and the 20th. The first maintenance payment shall be due on December 5, 1994. The obligation to pay future maintenance is terminated:

upon the death of either party or the remarriage of the party receiving maintenance.

Other: Maintenance shall also terminate in the event the wife cohabitates with an unrelated adult male.

Maintenance shall terminate when the wife ceases to be a full-time student at an institution of higher learning. Full-time student or full-time enrollment shall be as defined by the institution of higher learning then being attended by the wife. To ensure compliance with this provision, the wife shall provide to the husband written verification prior to each semester/quarter regarding her full-time enrollment. At the end of the semester/quarter, the wife shall provide written verification that she did in fact attend school on a full-time basis. Notwithstanding any other provision, maintenance will terminate at the end of the last month following the 1999 fall quarter/semester of the relevant educational institution.

3.8 CONTINUING RESTRAINING ORDER.

3.9 PARENTING PLAN.

The parties shall comply with the Parenting Plan signed by the court on JUNE 5, 1995. The Parenting Plan signed by the court is approved and incorporated as part of this Decree.

3.10 CHILD SUPPORT.

Child support shall be paid in accordance with the order of child support signed by the court on JUNE 5, 1995. This order is incorporated as part of this Decree.

3.11 ATTORNEY'S FEES, OTHER PROFESSIONAL FEES AND COSTS.

Attorney's fees, other professional fees and costs shall be paid as follows:

The husband shall pay to the wife's attorney the sum of \$22,000.00. Said sum shall be paid from the husband's share of the sale proceeds from the home when the home is sold. If the husband's share is insufficient to paid said fees in full, any balance of said fees remaining will continue as a judgment and this judgment shall accrue interest at the rate of 10% per year.

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3.12 NAME CHANGES.

The Respondent/wife's name shall be changed to Angela Marie Douglas.




